Fundraising Committee Report for May 12, 2014

1. Awaiting receipt of the two 2014 ornaments from Joan Dodge between now and May 30.
2. On Wednesday, May 7, Larry and I picked up our new Town Crocks from Salmon Falls Stoneware in Dover NH. We purchased 20 of each, pint and quart sizes. The new quarts will sell for \$29 each and the pints for \$22 each. They are very attractive with the new Elderberry vine design.
- 3 There is a delay in ordering the Camp mugs from American Crystal with the new Nettleton House design. They company is no longer accepting sketches as we did with the Opera House that we have been selling for the past 4 years. The design must be 300 dpi with camera ready graphics with a crisp image. I have asked Christina to help since her company as software to produce this type of image. She has agreed to help. Therefore, I have delayed ordering the 14 oz glasses with the Opera House graphics until I can submit both orders together.
4. We will be offering Set 3 of 12 Vintage Postcards. Larry has selected 12 new scenes and Pris is currently working on getting them ready for NCLS to print. We will have these available for the May 30 Farmers Market opening.
5. We are also working with Pris to design another 5 card ornament proof assortment of note cards, Set C. We already have Parlin Field and Sarah J. Hale. That leaves the Depot, Firehouse and Tiger Mascot proofs for Pris to design. These will also be ready for May 30.
6. We have signed up for the 2014 Season of the Newport Farmers Market (May 30 to October 10), Chamber Day (June 14 – 9 to 2), Apple Pie Craft Fair (August 23 – 9 to 3) Regarding the Farmers Market, we will need coverage for Friday June 6, Friday June 11 and Friday August 1 as Larry and I will be out of town.
7. Bacon Graphics is no longer in business. I have spoken with Jim Chrimes about availability of tee shirts and sweatshirts. He is aware that he still has a few of the transfers. He is going to do a few things on a part-time basis. We agreed to speak again before the end of this month about the tees and sweatshirts. There are others locally who can do them but the cost may vary.
