Fundraising Committee Report for June 13, 2016

- 1) We have a printing quote from NLCS on Jayna's Emerson Diary. The costs would be, using the same format as the "Peeks" book, \$11.00 per copy with all color or \$4.29 for color cover and black & white interior.
  
- 2) We have reordered and received 56 queen ornaments to replenish our supply for the coming season.
  
- 3) We have reordered note card assortments "A" and "B" featuring our original 10 ornament proofs, also the Corbin Covered Bridge and Courthouse proofs for stand-alone sets. These have been received. Also reordered and waiting are sets #3 and #4 of our Vintage post cards. These should be ready for pickup sometime this week.
  
- 4) We will also be ordering a reprint of the "Peeks" book as we have only 1 left.
  
- 5) We are out of the Finn book. I spoke with Ron Garceau who is turning the book printing over to NHS. As part of the transition, he will order 20 more books from Town & Country Reprographics in Concord, letting them know that NHS will be taking the ordering over as he is retiring and beginning to disengage from some projects. We will pay T & C directly and pick up the books in Concord.
  
- 6) We will no longer be offering the 3-D molded ornaments for sale on consignment. We also have sold out of the Jesse Scott books. There is a slim possibility that Maxine may do another small printing of 50 books; she prefers not to but is being pushed in that direction by close friends and family. Because of NHS willingness to help sell the books, Max has twice donated 10 books for us to sell resulting in a \$500 donation to NHS. Personally, I have told her that if she does order more book, we would be happy to help her sell them.
  
- 7) We have four Farmers Market Friday sales to-date. See page 8 of the Financial report for results. Friday, June 10's sales were \$142.
